



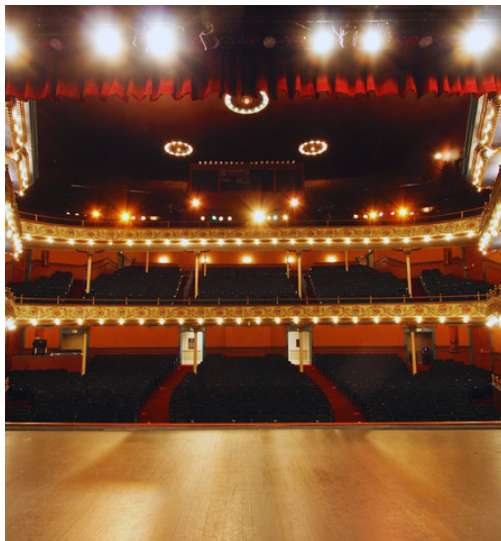
SHOW PACKET

DDS RECITAL 2023

Please take time to read this packet carefully as it is loaded with very important information! Also, make sure you save it as a reference tool for the week leading up to your dancer's big day!

DRESS REHEARSAL

Dress Rehearsal is a very important part of the Recital experience. This is the first time the dancers will perform full out in their costume with hair and make up on the stage.

WHEN: Friday June 2nd

WHERE: The Grand Opera House

DROP OFF LOCATION: Theatre back door in the alley. There will be a sign on the door and a volunteer present. A detailed diagram on the next page.

PROCESS:

All dancers will be dropped off at the back door behind the theatre in the back alley each dancer will have a DDS volunteer who will be in charge of their class back stage and help them change costumes if needed.

SHOULD MY DANCER ARRIVE TO DRESS REHEARSAL IN COSTUME?

Your dancer will need to arrive **DRESSED** in their **FIRST DANCE** costume. If the dancer only has one costume, they will still arrive in this costume. We ask that dancers have their hair and make up completed as well upon arrival at drop off. Please look at the show order in the packet to see what your dancer's first dance is.

WHAT DOES MY DANCER NEED BACKSTAGE?

Dancers only need their dance shoes in their dance bag and a bottle of **WATER**. We do not want to have colored drinks back stage for our dancers so we can limit stains on costumes backstage.

Snacks to send in: goldfish, pretzels. Please no toys or other items. Volunteers will have entertainment for our younger dancers for backstage time.

CAN I WATCH THE DRESS REHEARSAL?

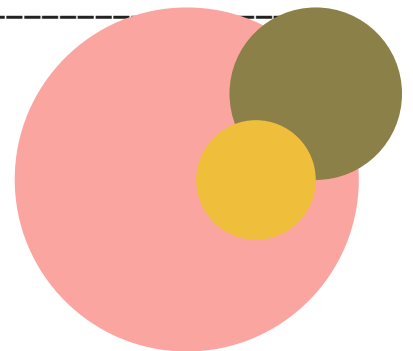
We always have a **CLOSED** rehearsal for our dancers and staff so we are able to prepare them for the stage with as limited distractions as possible. We also want you to enjoy the show **SATURDAY** once we have worked out all the kinks!

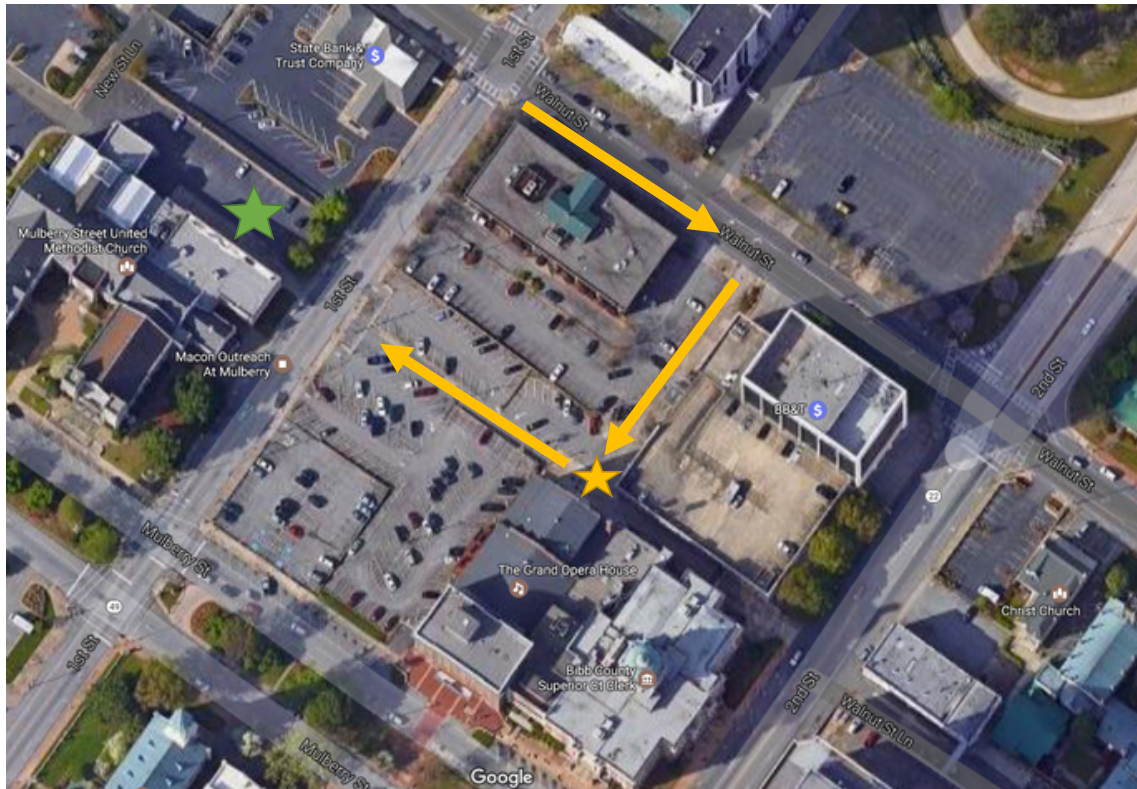

DROP OFF LOCATION



OPTION A: CARPOOL DROP OFF *recommended by the Grand Opera House*

From Walnut Street, turn RIGHT into the alley next to BB&T Bank. Please avoid the bank drive thru lanes. Continue straight to the back door of the theater (★) () where volunteers will be waiting to greet your dancer and walk them into their designated dressing room. After your child has safely exited your vehicle, continue to the right down Walnut Street Lane to exit onto First Street.

OPTION B: PARK and WALK

You may park in the Mulberry Methodist Parking lot (★) and walk your dancer to the backstage door (★) with all their dance items.

NO ONE, other than dancers, teachers and company volunteers, are allowed in the backstage areas. Our dance company volunteers will be waiting to attend to all your dancers' needs.

For **BOTH** rehearsal and recital **PICK-UP**, we will NOT use the carpool option. **ONE** parent must walk to the drop off area and pick your dancer up at the backstage door.

SHOW DAY

WHEN DO I ARRIVE TO THE THEATER?

Your dancer will arrive **ONE HOUR** before the show begins with their first costume on and hair and make-up done. Please refer to the bottom of this page for your exact arrival time.

WHERE DO I DROP OFF MY DANCER?

You will drop your dancer off at the back theatre door in the alley. A company mom volunteer and a company dancer will be waiting to greet your dancer and take them to their dressing room.

WHO CAN DROP OFF MY DANCER?

We ask that only **ONE PARENT** check in and drop off each dancer. No parents will be able to enter the dressing rooms. We have capable DDS staff members and volunteers to assist your dancers once they are checked in and dropped off. An identification card of dancers 5th grade and younger will be given to parents at You will need to have this card for pick up.

CHECK IN/CHECK OUT-PROCESS-

You will pick up your dancer in the alley at the back of the theatre. At drop off/check in, dancers that are younger than 6th grade will have a student identification card. Parents will be handed this card. At check out, hand this card back to the volunteer and they will locate your dancers dressing room. Parents of dancers 5th grade and below will need to have the dancer identification card for check out.

SHOULD MY DANCER ARRIVE TO THE RECITAL IN COSTUME?

Yes, we ask that they arrive dressed in their costume with their hair and make up done. This will keep things moving smoothly backstage for our dancers and volunteers. If they have multiple dances a DDS volunteer will be in the dressing room to assist with costume and hair changes. If your dancer has multiple costume/ hair changes, please have their costumes, shoes ad hair supplies organized, LABELED and readily available in a small bag or garment bag. Please note, if your dancer is only in one dance, we prefer they only bring their dance bag with dance shoes and water inside only.

SNACKS/FOOD IN THE DRESSING ROOM:

The *only* food allowed in the dressing rooms are goldfish, pretzels and water. All other snacks are *not* allowed.

MAKEUP & HAIR

DOES MY DANCER NEED TO WEAR MAKEUP?

Yes! The stage lights are bright, and the stage is large! All dancers will need to wear makeup. This will help make their faces stand out on stage and not be washed out by the stage lights.

For the younger dancers, we suggest blush and lipstick. The older dancers should wear blush, lipstick, eye makeup, and lashes. All dancers should look their best for SHOW DAY! For older dancers, we suggest using a lip stain with no gloss.

HELPFUL TIPS FOR ALL CLASSES:

- **Have hair and make-up done BEFORE you arrive to rehearsal & recital**
- **If you are in tap, jazz or Hip Hop, put tan tights on under your pink tights.**
- **Tack down any straps - use clear straps on any extra bra/nude undergarments.**
- **Bring a bag for all shoes, tights and costumes. Make sure EVERYTHING IS LABELED WITH YOUR DANCERS NAME.**
- **Keep all costume accessories labeled and in a clear zip-loc type bag.**

COSTUME - TIGHTS - HAIR INFO

All dancers need to arrive w/ costume on and hair already done.

3 year old: little braid into a high bun or pulled back to a high bun

4 year old classes: HIGH bun

5 year old, 1st Grade and 2nd Grade Classes: either double french braids into a LOW bun or hair pulled back to a LOW bun

3rd grade classes + above: DOUBLE FRENCH BRAID w/ a low bun

Tights - Capezio Style #1916

Ballet - Color: Ballet Pink (Peach color when in package)

Jazz, Lyrical and/or Tap - Color: Skin Tone

Light Suntan, Maple and Mocha are popular skin tone colors

Ballet Level 3 & Ballet Level 4 - Capezio #9 Knit seamed tights - Ballet Pink
